Prerequisites for applicants

Evaluation process

Please submit your full application to jobs@ipk-gatersleben.de before 31 January 2019, which will then be evaluated by a panel composed of scientists of the IPK and the Fördergemeinschaft (friends' association).

Salary and accomodation

The programme covers travel expenses (up to 1,000 EUR) to Gatersleben and back to your home affiliation. During your stay at IPK, you will receive a regular employment contract and a salary corresponding to your present status (M.Sc., PhD-student, postdoctoral researcher). IPK can provide apartments in its guesthouse according to availability or will provide assistance in finding accommodation outside the institute.
